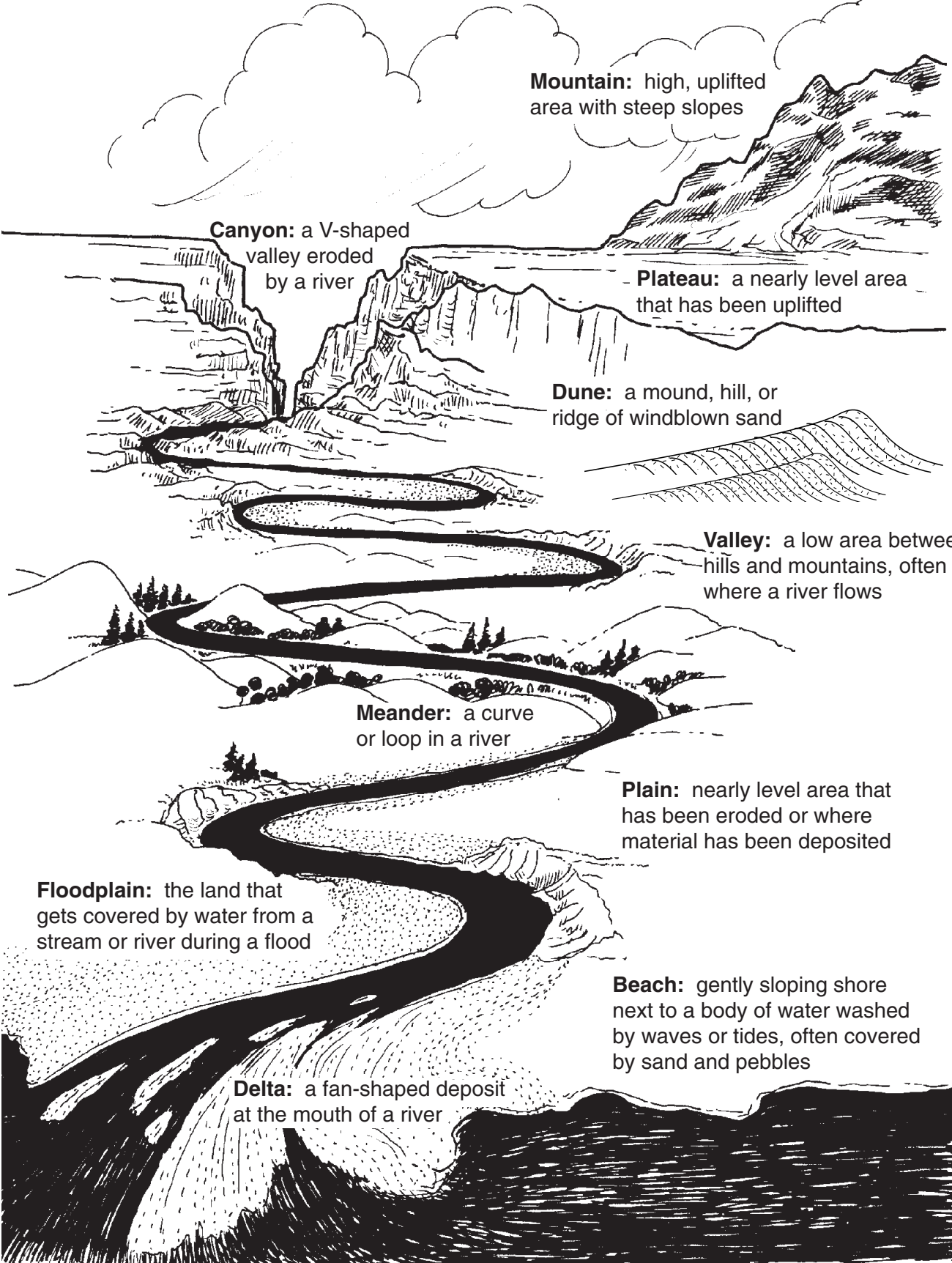


LANDFORMS VOCABULARY



Mountain: high, uplifted area with steep slopes

Canyon: a V-shaped valley eroded by a river

Plateau: a nearly level area that has been uplifted

Dune: a mound, hill, or ridge of windblown sand

Valley: a low area between hills and mountains, often where a river flows

Meander: a curve or loop in a river

Plain: nearly level area that has been eroded or where material has been deposited

Floodplain: the land that gets covered by water from a stream or river during a flood

Beach: gently sloping shore next to a body of water washed by waves or tides, often covered by sand and pebbles

Delta: a fan-shaped deposit at the mouth of a river
