- Washable Markers, 8-count
- Colored Pencils, 12-Count Box
- Crayons, 24-count box
- 6 Glue Sticks, 1 in pencil box and 5 in a labeled baggie
- 1 White School glue (4 oz. bottle) – label with name
- 2 Red Ink Pens (ballpoint, not gel), 1 in pencil box, 1 in glue stick baggie.
- 4 Blue Ink Pens (ballpoint, not gel), 1 in pencil box, 3 in glue stick baggie.
- 4 packages of wide-ruled lined paper (at least 150 count) (may need more later in the year), to be put in community supply area.
- 1 wide-ruled composition book
- 6 24-packs of Number 2 pencils (will be kept in a community area) (more pencils may be needed later in the year)
- White Pentel Hi-Polymer Eraser (at least one) – write name right on the eraser
- 5-7” Scissors, pointed tip – label with name
- 2 Pencil Boxes – label with name
- 5-Two Pocket Folders ; at least one should be a poly folder (more durable for homework)
- 3 spiral notebooks
- Flash Drive for technology
- Lunch Box with ice pack, if not taking hot lunch
- Water Bottle with a sweat cover of some type and a pop-up nozzle or straw -- please don't send one that has to be opened completely up -- they spill!
- Sturdy Backpack – Third-grade books are heavy!
- Agenda/Assignment Book -- Will Be Available For Purchase At Trinity
- 1 Bible - If you need a new bible, please pick up an English Standard Version (ESV) in the school office. The cost is \$22.00 each. Do not feel obligated to purchase a new bible if the one you have is still in good condition.
- +/- Flash Cards for use at home (Mad Dog Math Cards recommended; some are available in my classroom (\$15) or may be ordered through MadDogMath.com). Any brand of flashcards are acceptable, however, as long as your child will use them!
- Will need multiplication/division flash cards later in the year (wait to purchase until I tell you specific requirements)
