- D. being in a state of putrefaction : rotten
- E. a large usually metal or pottery vessel (as for wine) with handle and spout and often a lid
- F. a room in many English and French medieval manor houses, great houses and castles, generally situated on an upper storey, designed as the family's private living and sleeping quarters
- G. A difficult situation or problem
- H. a person who predicts the future by magical, intuitive, or more rational means
- I. A Christian sacrament; Voluntary self-punishment inflicted as an outward expression of repentance for having done wrong
