

Medieval Journal Project Checklist

Directions: You are assuming a role of a medieval person during the middle ages. Write at least **4 journal entries**, one for each season of the year: fall, winter, spring, and summer. Each journal entry must contain a **minimum of 100 words**. Use the checklist below to be sure you have included all the necessary information. **You must date your entries and put them in chronological order.** You may do extra journal entries, but only after you have met the requirements of these four entries. One-sentence entries may be used to create voice and humor, but they will not count as one of your four main entries.

JOURNAL ENTRY #1

Introduce yourself. Look at Catherine's journal entry on the 19th day of September for a good example.

- Season fall
- Your name and age
- Social status (royalty, nobility, vassal, serf, townspeople)
- Setting: include place (town, countryside, castle, England, etc.) & time (day, month, year)
- Conflict with another person, self, nature, or society

JOURNAL ENTRY #2

- Season winter
- Holiday or medieval festival
- Conflict with another person, self, nature, or society
- Food, music, dance, clothing, and/or art

JOURNAL ENTRY #3

- Season spring
- Daily activities or chores
- Conflict with another person, self, nature, and/or society
- Food, music, dance, clothing, or art

JOURNAL ENTRY #4

- Season summer
- Daily activities or chores
- Resolution to conflict(s) with another person, self, nature, and/or society
- Food, music, dance, clothing or art
