<p><u>Word</u></p> <p>universities</p>	<p><u>Definition</u></p> <p>Who: mostly clergy, sons of nobles What: schools of advanced learning that take the place of cathedral schools; students study subjects such as Latin grammar, rhetoric (persuasive writing & speaking), logic, geometry, arithmetic, astronomy & music When: beginning in the 1200’s CE Where: mostly in large medieval European cities located on or near church grounds Why: mostly studying for careers in the clergy How: by listening and memorizing since books were expensive, hand copied, & rare So What: increased education; spread Latin; led to scholars like Thomas Aquinas who bridged the gap between ancient philosophies based in reason & church teachings based on faith which were later taught & promoted by the church</p>
