

# World History: Mrs. Schoch

## 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Extra Credit Option

Point Value: Worth UP to 100 extra credit points. Each Stamp is worth up to 25 points. You can do any or all of the stamps. What you do and how well you have followed the directions will detail how much extra credit you receive.

Due Date: ON or BEFORE **Wednesday, January 11, 2012** / Thursday, January 12, 2012. (Hint: Don't Procrastinate! Turn it in *early*)

### The Assignment:

1. Students are to choose a topic we have covered from Unit 1 (chapters 1-5) that intrigued and interested them.
2. Students are to create 4 (four) stamps that represent the topic they have chosen. (Hint: look at your study guides for inspiration)
  - a. For Example: The Role of the Church in Medieval Europe
    - i. A pictorial representation of the organization of the Roman Catholic Church
    - ii. A pictorial representation of the influence of the Roman Catholic Church's influence on art and architecture, education, and/or philosophy
    - iii. A pictorial representation of important Medieval European holidays
    - iv. A pictorial representation of the lives and contributions of Medieval monks, nuns, and mendicants
  - b. Students will create a visual image of each of the four items such as those listed above (or from the topic the student chooses to showcase) using creativity and imagination.
    - i. Personal drawings, magazine pictures cut out, and/or clip art (may not be total picture) may be used. You may NOT take a complete picture from the Internet and turn it in as your own work. You may use it for inspiration or to replicate partial images.
    - ii. Write the topic the stamps are to represent at the top of your stamp as well as what the picture represents.
  - c. A single copy of a stamp has been given to you to use, copy, or trace as needed.
