On Monday, Oct. 6, second grade teachers will attend a math training for the new Math program. We will attend four other trainings on Oct. 23, Nov. 13, Dec. 11 and Feb. 25.

In Social Studies we are learning mapping skills and directions. Then we will learn about our government and the electoral process. We will have a mock election on Nov. 2. In Gifts Around the World we will be studying about Spain.

In Science we are finishing a unit called "What Makes Me Sick:", focusing on how germs spread, safety, and healthy nutrition choices. We will start a unit on Energy and Motion.

In Language Arts, we are finishing our first unit in Open Court, "Sharing Stories" and then we will be starting the second unit, "Kindness". Every story in each unit lasts a week and has many activities worked into it like spelling, writing, vocabulary, grammar, penmanship, phonics, comprehension, and mechanics.

In Math we are finishing our unit on Numbers and Patterns to 200. The next unit will be on Geometry and Fractions.
