**Psychology – Understanding Self: Collage (TEST GRADE)**



**Task: Learn about yourself by using pictures and words to describe you.**

**Procedures:**

1. Look through magazines, newspapers, Google images, etc., to find pictures, cartoons, words, and phrases you feel best describes or represents some aspect of you.
2. Arrange and glue these words and images on poster board.
3. Share your poster with the class.

**Journal entry - include the following information:**

1. Do you see any trends or themes in your pictures?
2. What images show your feelings?
3. How is this collage of you different from one you might have done one year ago?
4. How do you think a collage of you might be different one year from now?
5. How do you think a collage of you might be different five years from now?
6. What did you learn about yourself?
7. Was there something new you had not thought of earlier?
8. Was there something you would like to change? Why or why not?

**Grading: You will be graded according to the following criteria:**

**Poster: 60 points**

1. *The display is attractive, creative, and interesting.*
2. *The ideas are presented clearly.*
3. *The display's message is clear.*
4. *Pictures, photographs, drawings, diagrams, and other elements add information and make ideas clear.*
5. *Poster clearly describes you.*
