IMPORTANT REMINDERS



MCS D "No Idling" Policy: Please be aware that drivers are not to leave vehicles idling while on school district property. This applies to both morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up. Not only will this save you gasoline, it will protect the lungs of our precious children.

MCS D Dress Code: As printed in the '11-'12 MCS D Behavior Code and Discipline Policy, students are not allowed to wear: "tank tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops", "shower shoes, flip flops, or bedroom shoes, nor heels higher than 2 inches". "Dresses and skirts may be worn with the length to be no higher than 3 inches above the top of the knee cap." Shorts may be worn with the length to be no higher than 3 inches above the top of the knee cap. **Athletic shorts may only be worn for physical education classes.**
