All candidates are asked to participate. There will be a composite picture of the entire class. When proofs are returned to us, you will be asked to choose the pose you wish to appear in the composite. None of this obligates you to purchase any pictures.

I ask you to follow the "Dress Code" as listed below.

Girls

white dress
white stockings
white shoes
white veil or flowers in the hair.

Boys

white shirt
dark dress pants or suit. * * *
dress shoes
tie, an appropriate subtle color.

*** * * Suit is optional. Coats are optional during the First Communion Mass.**

The photographer has a prayer book and rosary for your child to hold....or you may want your child to hold a prayer book or rosary that is a family treasure. Children can hold nothing and just fold their hands. We were shown pictures in which girls wore gloves or not... and some girls held flowers together with a prayer book and rosary...**YOU TELL THE PHOTOGRAPHER HOW YOU WANT YOUR SON/DAUGHTER** photographed that night. Last year's composite will be available for viewing.
