In Class This Week ...

English Language Arts

Our two new star words this week are "and" and "for."

We will continue with our study of rhyming words. You can help with this skill by saying different pairs of words and let your child decide if they rhyme or not. Also, you can give your child a word and have your child give you a word that rhymes with your word.

In Foundations, our new letters are "x" and "y." These are our last letters to learn! On Tuesday, your child will come with handwriting homework for letters "x" and "y." Your child's

letter bag will come home on Thursday to find items that start with "x" and "y."

Math

The number for this week is 20. This week, we will practice, one to one correspondence. One to one correspondence is when a student has that certain number of items as the number listed. For example, if a student has the number 16, the student needs to have 16 of whatever items we are using. This is a skill that will be assessed for second nine weeks. This skill can be practiced at home by using things as simple as beans. Instruct your child to

give you a certain number of beans, and your child needs to count out that number of beans.

Science/Social Studies

On Monday, we will have a visit from the State Police.

This week, we will discuss healthy eating and the food pyramid, and we will create healthy Thanksgiving meals.
