

Place It!

Players: 2 -4 Equipment : deck of cards (A-9 only), paper & pencil

Game set up:

1. Each player draws 5 sets of 3 blank lines (hundreds, tens, ones)
2. Stack deck of cards in center

How to play:

1. Players take turns taking one card each & deciding blank space to fill
2. Player one, draw one card & choose which place to write it in
3. Next player draws one card & chooses place to write the number
4. Play continues until all players have filled the 3 blank lines
5. Players then take turn reading the numbers they created
6. Player that has the largest number WINS

RULE: Once players write a number/fill a space it can not be changed.

Ways to Change the Game :

*Players try to create the smallest number

*Players add another space making numbers into the thousands place

*Players add the 'joker' cards & use them as WILD (can be any number)

*Change the rule to players CAN move numbers to a new place at the end of the game before taking turns reading numbers.
