Do parents and students have to attend?

Medfield High School Band and Orchestra members will be on hand giving first instrumental lessons to beginning students! Please make every effort to attend, so your child can have their first lesson immediately upon receiving their new instrument.

What time should I be there?

You may walk-in anytime between 4:30-7:00 PM. There will not be a presentation this year.

How long should I plan on being there?

You should expect to be there approximately 45 minutes to one hour including the instrument rental and first lesson. Orchestra students may also need to be sized for their new instrument.

How long is the commitment to band or orchestra?

Participation in band or orchestra at Dale Street is a one year commitment. We certainly hope that it will remain part of your child's life for years to come!

What does my child need to participate in Band or Orchestra this year?

Please see the attached list of required materials. All required materials should be available through Music & Arts at Rental Night for your convenience. If you already own an instrument you may not need to rent one. The instrument should be of good quality and in top playing condition to ensure your child's success. You are encouraged to bring any family-owned instruments to Rental Night for evaluation. Books, reeds and other required accessories will be available at Rental Night.

Can students switch instruments during the school year?

Students may not switch instruments during the school year.

What is the cost of renting an instrument?

Pricing information is on the attached pricing sheet from the rental company – Music & Arts. Please note the special introductory offer is three months. After three months, families are responsible for continuing to rent the instrument through the remainder of the school year. See the pricing sheet for monthly rates.
