



KM News Week of Nov. 10-14

This week we continued our family and Thanksgiving theme. We read great stories about families, such as: 7 Silly Eaters (parents would love this book!) and Sylvester And The Magic Pebble. We also read Sally's Room, which is a silly story about the dangers of having a messy room! We also spent time each day practicing our Thanksgiving songs and poems.

This week each child made a book about his/her family. They worked hard on writing and illustrating each page of their special book. You will have the chance to see your child's book at our Thanksgiving Celebration next week.

This week we read our next silly sentence, which was about Ricka Raccoon. The kids brainstormed R words, spied R objects around the room, and identified missing R words in the sentence. We have also been working on reading sight words in our daily newsletter each morning. The kids like being "word detectives" and eagerly volunteer to find and circle particular words on the chart paper. Ask your child about our classroom word wall in the Writing Center.

We had a great time with our 4F buddies this week. Everyone made turkeys using paper cut outs of their hands and feet. The buddies had fun chatting and creating together!

During stay days this week, the kids worked on the letters H and K in their handwriting books. Please practice them at home 😊. We also continued our study of patterns this week. Everyone created pattern snakes using pattern blocks. First, they created a linear pattern with the blocks, and then copied their pattern by

gluing paper pattern blocks onto a snake shaped paper. The kids also worked on a syllable sorting activity together in group.
