Each quadrant of your shield should contain ART* ONLY that reveals who you are and what you stand for. The **Mantle** at the top of the shield must state your name as follows: Boys: Sir ____ (First Name) of ____ (Last Name), Girls: Lady ____ (First Name) of ____ (Last Name). But the way you do your name should also reveal something about you: bold colors= bold personality, red/white/blue = you're patriotic, etc. **Q1: Family & Friends**, **Q2: Meaningful Things** (qualities you admire, life goals, religion, etc.), **Q3: Hobbies & Interests**, **Q4: Books** you've read or would like to read and or the type of books you like (mystery, fantasy, drama, etc. Your shield must be cut out from this sheet and mounted on something sturdy like--cardboard, posterboard, etc. NOT WOOD!

*Art can include: photos, clip art, stickers, hand-drawn, etc. Also, some art unavoidably has text on it, like a book cover. That's fine!
