**CYO Dance Rules 2009- 2010**

1. Dance hours are **7:30 p.m. through 10:00 p.m.** No admittance until 7:30 p.m. The cost of admittance is **\$10.00**. The first bottle of water is free, each additional bottle of water is \$1.00.
2. All belongings, bags, purses, cell phones, etc. are **NOT** allowed in the gym for the dance. Store all belongings on the stage in the all-purpose room before entrance into the dance. Once you are admitted to the dance, you will not be allowed back to your belongings until the end of the dance, unless accompanied by an adult.
3. Once you are admitted to the dance, you must stay in the gym until approximately 8:00 p.m. when the admission rush is over.
4. No inappropriate dressing. "Out-of-Uniform Day" attire should be your guideline. If you are not allowed to wear your outfit for a school "Out-of-Uniform" day, then don't wear it to the dance.
5. **There will be someone at the door checking that the dress code is being enforced.**

**DRESS CODE:**

**Girls will NOT be admitted** in HALTER-TOPS, TUBE TOPS, SPAGHETTI STRAP SHIRTS, MIDRIFT SHIRTS, ONE-SHOULDER SHIRTS, and ANY KIND OF REVEALING SHIRT. Sleeveless shirts with thick shoulder straps are allowed.

**SKIRTS/SHORTS MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN MID-THIGH.**

**Boys will not be admitted** in sleeveless undershirts or inappropriate pants.

**SOFT SOLED SHOES ONLY PLEASE**

If you get into the dance and change or take-off the cover-up shirt that was appropriate to get into the dance and you are now dressed inappropriately, you will be taken out of the dance and your parents will be called and you will be sent home.

6. **NO FREAK DANCING** or inappropriate dancing is allowed.
7. **NO** inappropriate behavior. This includes kissing or inappropriate touching. You will be taken out of the dance and parents will be called and you will be sent home.
8. **NO** glow sticks or hand-held laser lights of any kind are allowed at the dance.
9. **NO** drinks are allowed in the gym.
10. **NO** fighting of any kind. All parties will be sent home from the dance.
11. Once in the dance you will not be permitted outside or leave without an adult. If you will be picked up early, the adult must come into the dance to get you. If you need to use a phone, find a chaperone and one will be provided for emergencies only.
12. **NO DRUGS OR ALCOHOL OR WEAPONS ARE PERMITTED AT ANY TIME.**

As with past dances, we don't expect any problems. Please be respectful of the rules and let's continue to keep these dances as fun as they have been.
