

Fan-Fold Display

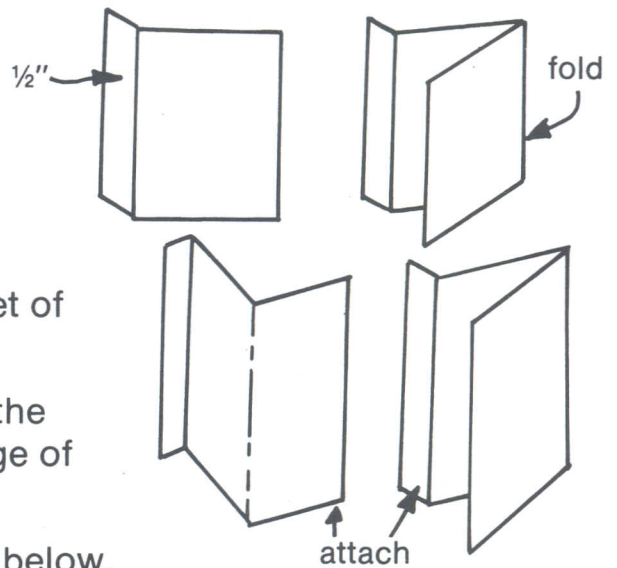
Make a fan-fold display about a book you have read.

You need:

- 3 sheets of 9" X 12" construction paper
- crayons or markers
- glue or paste

Directions:

1. Fold a 1/2" edge along one side of each sheet of paper. Then fold the sheets in half.
2. Attach the three sheets together by gluing the folded edge of one sheet to the straight edge of the next.
3. Complete your fan-fold display as directed below.



B. Draw, label, and describe the setting (where and when the story takes place).

D. Draw five pictures about the book in the numbered spaces. Label them *First, Second, Next, Then, and Finally*.
(10 points for each picture or 50 points total)

A. Write the title, author, and your name. Add a picture.
(10 points)

C. Draw and label the main characters in the story. (10 points)

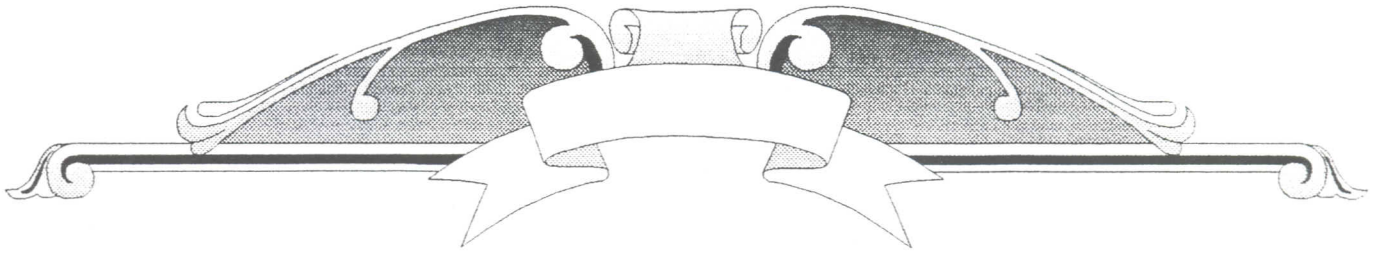
Write your opinion of the book. Tell why you would or would not recommend it to others.
