Absences and Make up Work

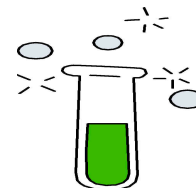

Rules

 - Severe acts will be dealt with swiftly and severely while steps on the scale may be skipped. THIS MAY INCLUDE REMOVAL FROM CLASS WITH A FAILING GRADE.

Work Ethic Points

1. Students can earn 3 work ethic points daily by:
 - Attending class on time
 - Working on class related work throughout the class period
 - Being prepared to learn and participate in class
 - Participating in class activities with a positive attitude
2. The maximum number of points will NOT be earned when:
 - A student arrives late to class (unexcused)
 - A student does not hand in or obtain assignments prior to their absence (this includes school related absences)
 - The attendance office is not notified in advance of an absence
 - Class is skipped.
