MATHEMATICS
Develops number sense for whole numbers through 30. (1-10)
Connects model, number word (orally), and number using a variety of representations. (1-10)
Counts objects in a set.

Sorts and classifies objects by one attribute

RECEPTIVE LANGUAGE (READING/LISTENING)	EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE (WRITING/SPEAKING)
Recognizes words that rhyme when spoken	Uses drawing or symbols to convey ideas or information
Know that spoken language is made up of separate sounds that make words	Uses words to express needs and wants
Recognizes own name	Names common objects
Recognizes print such as signs, labels, and trademarks	Responds appropriately to questions
Points to the front of a book, back of a book, and the title	Uses random letters in writing
Points to where a story begins	Writes own first name
Knows letters and words are read left to right	
Points to a single letter in a page of text	Uses upper and lower case letters interchangeably in writing
Points to the first word read on a page of text	
Predicts what might happen in a text before reading	
Chooses to read and look at different kinds of books and selections	
Understands and follows 1 and 2 step spoken and/or picture directions	
Listens to stories	
Goes back to stories read or heard to reread and enjoy	
Chooses own text to read or look at for at least 5 minutes daily
