Communications -

Operations – Directory is complete. 1245 copies were published. Extra copies are available for \$2.00. Total cost was \$1800 under budget. The newsletter for the quarter is complete. 30 were printed for those that do not want to receive it via email. Cultural arts are rotating events as planned through the various tracks. They will be under budget and suggest reallocating funds to teacher grants.

Services – The pantry for the teachers has recently been stocked. Hospitality has asked for more notice for upcoming events.

Ways and Means – Book Fair grossed \$7048 against a goal of \$10,000. ZPizza spirit night yielded \$240.00. The next spirit night is in January at Chick Fillet.

Treasurer – Reviewed budget. It was highlighted that \$3000. of teacher grant money was not spent.

District 8 meetings – Jennifer reported on the last meeting. The node assignments are being rearranged for 2008-09. Students that opted for traditional calendars are not guaranteed a place in their current school. They will be offered a “less convenient school”. 3 new elementary schools are opening in 2008.

Patti Smith attended the meeting to propose issuing a survey to parents that would serve to document and report the experience and opinion of year round calendars. Various options of how to deliver the survey were discussed. It was agreed the survey would be created and delivered through parent groups and not the school or the PTA.
