Pole Vault: This is an exciting time for the track and field team. We have two male athletes that have graduated to 13 ft poles. Because of this change, beginning next week, Schuyler Community Schools will become a helmet required school for pole-vaulters. All pole-vaulters (7-12) will have a school issued helmets.

Gym updates:

SCHS Gym: The railings have been placed on the end of the bleachers. Meyo Enterprises is scheduled to come back on May 21st to straighten the seats that are bent along with bolting back the first row on the East side.

During the inspection of the gym, as a recap, we have a cable that is frayed. It is rubbing on the knee brace of the backboard along with the fire sprinklers. After visiting with Mr. Stevens, I asked Meyo for a bid to fix this. The bid is for \$2282.10. Mr. Stevens has approved this bid so the cable is repaired and there is no more rubbing from the cable system on the knee brace and fire sprinklers. Meyo is coming on May 21st and May 22nd to finish up the West Gym.

SMS Gym: There are six retractable backboards at SMS. Mr. Stevens has approved to put the Posilock safety straps on these backboards. The bid for this is \$4442.50. Meyo is coming on August 6th to install the Posilocks on the backboards and will lube and inspect the bleachers on May 22nd.

Both bids were placed on the same paper and are included as an attachment.

I continue to be active with the NSAA rep assembly. We had a meeting at Boys Town on April 4th and will have our last one on April 13th. The biggest item of interest is the way the submission of proposals is given to the NSAA from the membership. There will be two forms of submission. Either through caucus or via district meetings. I believe this is an improved method. As all things – time will tell.

I have been entering our 2012-2013 athletic schedules in the new web site. It is not live, but will be when this is completed. I would like to give you a timeline, but cannot at this time.
