1. Each point earned will accumulate towards 10; a total of 10 pts. per school year; a hearing is required to consider a L.T. suspension/expulsion.
2. All tardies are unexcused in school--consequences begin after the 3rd tardy of the quarter.
3. Only medical/funeral absences will be excused with a doctor/dentist note for medical/parent excused funeral.
4. Principal, or his designee, will only be allowed to issue an "admittance to class" slips.
5. Any illegal activities (Level 3B & 3C) will warrant police involvement.
6. After any student has accumulated 6 points, a conference will be held with the principal, counselor, teachers, parents, and student.
7. Students will be given the opportunity to earn points back upon the completion of ISS/OSS after the six point conference has been held.
8. Five consecutive, referral free days after satisfactory completion of ISS/OSS = 1 point earned back.
9. Zero is the base for this point system, there is no banking of points.
10. The Principal has the final authority to set level and consequence for any office referral.
