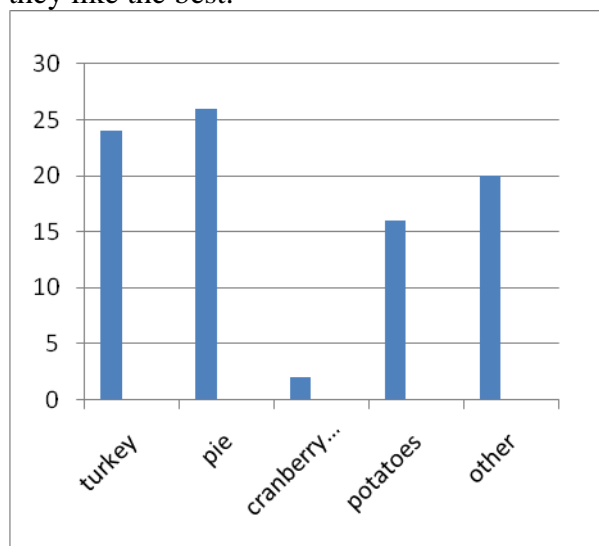

Scoop -Would you like to be a full-time teacher?

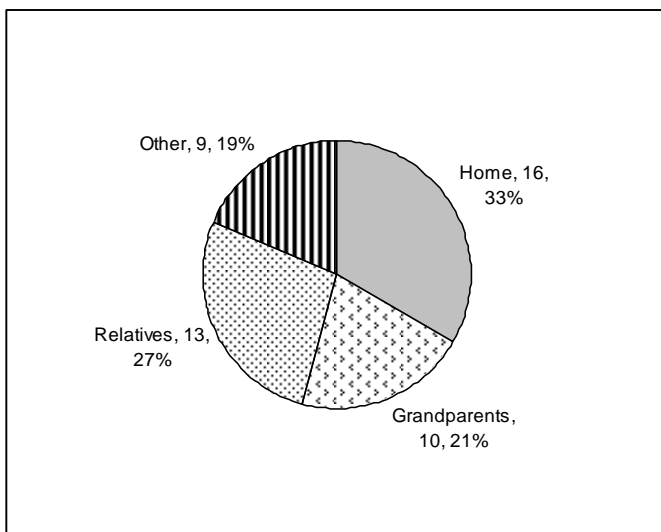
Mrs. A-That would be wonderful!
