## 2011-2012 Supply List

*Purchasing these supplies helps the school and your child's classroom. However, if acquiring these supplies is a hardship, please see the office staff.*

### KINDERGARTEN

- 2 solid-color durable plastic pocket folders (one with prongs)
- 1 Composition notebook for Library
- 12 pencils (sharpened, if possible) (no fancy pencils, please)
- 1 box crayola crayons (**24 or less**)
- 1 box basic 8 color crayola markers
- 1 box watercolor paints
- 2 big pink erasers
- 1 roll scotch tape
- 1 8-ounce bottle of glue
- 12 glue sticks
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 box facial tissues
- Boys: 1 box colored pencils  
1 box sandwich- or quart-size Ziploc-style baggies
- Girls: 1 container disinfecting wipes  
1 bottle hand sanitizer or liquid soap

*Please understand all items will be shared so no names are necessary.*

*Also, your teacher will let you know when supplies need to be replenished throughout the year.*

### 1ST GRADE

*Please label with your child's name:*

- 1 large backpack (able to hold folders & lunch)
- 1 small (8"x5") pencil/school box
- 1 box crayons (24 count)
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 box water-based Crayola basic/classic markers
- 1 set of watercolor paints with brush
- 1 roll transparent tape
- 1 pair scissors (Fiskar style, plastic handles with metal blades if possible)
- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters

*Please do not label—community supplies:*

- 24 wooden #2 pencils (suggested: Dixon Ticonderoga, PaperMate)
- 1 large gum eraser
- 1 pkg. pencil top erasers
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pkg (4-5 count) **black** dry-erase markers
- 1 ream copy/laser paper
- 2 roll paper towels
- 2 large boxes facial tissue
- Boys: 1 box sandwich-size Ziploc-style baggies
- Girls: 1 box gallon-size Ziploc-style baggies

### 2ND GRADE

- 1 backpack

- 3 pocket folders w/fasteners (red, blue, yellow)
- 1 durable plastic folder with prongs
- 1 ream copy/laser paper
- 36 pencils (#2 lead – Ticonderoga or PaperMate brand)
- 6 big pink erasers
- 1 box crayons (24 count)
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 package primary colors water-based markers
- 1 pkg. dry erase markers (4 or 5, primary colors)
- 1 old, clean sock (for dry-erase eraser)
- 1 pair Fiskar scissors – pointed tip
- 1 bottle white glue
- 8 glue sticks
- 1 set of coins (4- 25¢, 10- 10¢, 20- 5¢, 10- 1¢)
- 1 water bottle (plastic, re-sealable)
- 1 large box facial tissues
- 1 roll paper towels
- Boys: 1 bottle waterless hand sanitizer (7 oz. or larger)
- Girls: 1 container Clorox wipes

  - 1 pkg notebook paper (wide line)
  - 1 ream copy/laser paper
  - 2 spiral notebooks (wide ruled, not divided)
  - 4 pocket folders (2 w/prongs, 2 w/o prongs)
  - 36 #2 lead pencils (no fancy pencils, please)
  - 1 box colored pencils
  - 1 hand-held pencil sharpener
  - 1 eraser or 2 boxes of pencil top erasers
  - 1 pencil case
  - 1 box crayons
  - 1 box waterbased markers (wide tip)
  - 1 set watercolors
  - 1 pkg. dry erase markers
  - 1 pair scissors (pointed tip)
  - 1 12-inch ruler
  - 1 roll of clear tape
  - 4 glue sticks
  - 2 large boxes facial tissues
  - 1 bottle waterless hand sanitizer

- 1 pkg 12 colored pencils
- 1 pencil sharpener (hand-held w/enclosure)
- 1 eraser OR pkg pencil-top erasers
- 1 set water-based markers
- 1 box crayons (optional)
- 1 pkg dry-erase markers
- 1 Sharpie
- 1 pair scissors, pointed tips
- 1 ruler (metric and inch)
- 1 roll clear tape
- 1 glue stick
- 1 small bottle glue
- 1 roll paper towels
- 2 box facial tissues (large)
