Bosque School will host its annual Fall Fiesta Cross Country Invitational meet on Saturday 24 September 2011. It will be in conjunction with our Fall Fiesta and Homecoming Weekend. This race is primarily for A-AAA schools. Larger schools should call Craig Snow Athletic Director to discuss before registering.

There is an alumni and community 5K fun run at 7:30 AM for any interested runner (coaches are welcome and there is no fee for coaches. Coaches do not need to pre-register). Fun Run race registration at www.active.com

The Course

This course is relatively flat and quick. It winds in and out of the Rio Grande's riverside forest on dirt roads and trails. It travels past a city park with numerous wood carvings, the river itself, a thick cottonwood forest, ditch banks, and the Bosque School campus and its soccer fields.

Location & Directions

Bosque School is located just south of the Coors and Montano intersection on Albuquerque's north-west side. 4000 Learning Road, NW, Albuquerque, NM 87120. (505) 898-6388.

From Interstate 25: Take Montano Blvd. west across the Rio Grande. Turn south (left) on Coors Blvd (the first traffic light after crossing the river). Turn east (left) at the next traffic light Learning Road and curve east and then north to reach the school and course.

From Interstate 40: Take Coors Blvd. north for 2.6 miles. Turn east (right) at the Dellyne/Learning Road traffic light and curve east and then north to reach the school and course.

Registration

There is a \$20 registration fee for each school to pay for the awards and supplies. If a school is running only boys or only girls the fee is \$10. If a school has any middle school runners there is a \$10 fee. Complete the attached registration form and return it by 15 September 2010.

After 15 September, call to determine if there is space and a registration procedure.

Awards

Awards are as follows: Top 2 varsity teams will receive a plaque. Top 5 varsity individuals will receive a medal, 6th to 15th place in varsity receive a ribbon. Top 10 JV individuals receive a ribbon. There will be no team awards for JV races. Middle school top 3 runners receive a medal, 4 through 15th receive a ribbon.
