

Dear Families:

Our 100th Day of School Celebration is fast approaching! It is scheduled to take place in our classroom on January 26th. As part of our festivities, I am asking each student in my class to count and collect 100 small objects, and to place those objects in the plastic bag provided labeled "My 100th Day Collection."

Be creative and remember that all items must be from the same group (for example: 100 marbles or 100 stickers not 50 marbles and 50 stickers). Students will be asked to share their collections with the class and they will be displayed in the classroom for a few days. All items will be returned home within one week. It is important that each bag close securely over the 100 objects, so please help your child count and choose 100 objects small enough to fit in the bag.

Here are some collection ideas:

- 100 pieces of popcorn
- 100 paper clips
- 100 stickers
- 100 metal washers
- 100 rubber bands
- 100 hair elastics
- 100 stamps
- 100 toothpicks
- 100 pennies
- 100 pieces of cereal
- 100 beans
- 100 pictures of toys (or animals, etc.) cut from catalogs



Please consider the items on this list to be suggestions only. Feel free to help your child collect any 100 objects that will fit into his or her bag. I only ask that you avoid objects that are sharp (such as tacks) or that might cause allergies (such as peanuts). Your child's 100th Day of School Collection is due to school **no earlier than Friday, January 23rd**.
