

PHOTO STORY 3 COMPUTER CLASS PROJECT

The first computer class project of the new semester is going to be in Photo Story. We will be creating a “Getting to Know You” presentation which will be shown to the class using the projector and Smart Board. I would like all students to upload 10 pictures of their family, friends, and interests/hobbies onto MOODLE (see instructions below). This is an on-line site where you can transfer digital files online and access those files from home or anywhere else. If you are not able to go on-line, images can be burned to a CD. Photo Story allows import of most image formats, including .bmp, .dib, .eps, .gif, .jhif, .jpe, .jpeg, .jpg, .pcd, .pcx, .png, .psd, .rle, .tga, and .tif. It will not accept images burned using iPhoto. Each presentation will be approximately 3 minutes in length and when finished your child will be able to upload via MOODLE his or her completed presentation in Windows Media Video (.wmv) file format so you can view it at home or on a smart phone or i-pod. The picture files for this presentation are due by Monday, September 19th

INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPLOADING/DOWNLOADING DIGITAL FILES/PICTURES TO MOODLE (i-CAMPUS)

1. Go to UVMS web page. (<http://teacherweb.com/NY/Arlington/MrKerins/SDHPI.stm>)
2. Click on “MOODLE HOME TO SCHOOL” in the left column.
3. Click on “MOODLE HOME TO SCHOOL” link.
4. Log into MOODLE with student id and password. (password is student id number)
5. Click YES to enroll in this course (if not already a member).
