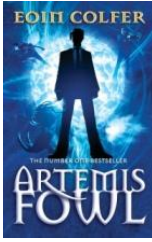

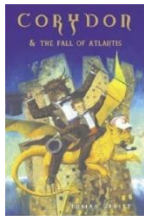

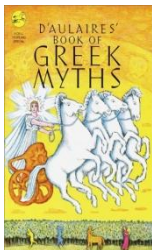


### Corydon & the Fall of Atlantis

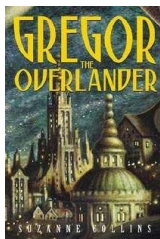

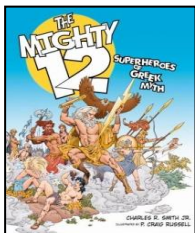


### Gregor the Overlander

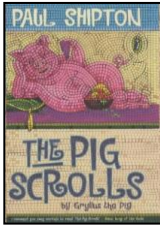

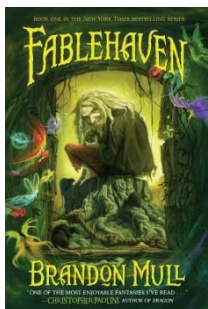
