AWARD — The 2009 DDMS Scholarships will be grants to three deserving students in the amounts of \$7500, \$6500, and \$5500. In addition, a \$600 grant will be awarded to each Area Winner not receiving one of the three scholarship awards. The scholarship(s) will be grants for the Freshman year.

ELIGIBILITY — Women students residing in New York State who are planning to major in Physical Education Teacher Education are eligible.

BASIS OF AWARD — The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of character, academic achievement, physical education competence, participation in athletics, qualities of leadership (including membership in Leaders' Clubs, Girls' Athletic Associations and similar organizations) and financial need.

APPLICATION — Requests for application forms should be made either through your **Area DDMS chairperson** designated on the back of this brochure or from the **NYSAHPERD** website www.nysahperd.org. Include the name and address of your high school in your request for an application. The completed application forms must be returned to your **Area DDMS Scholarship chairperson** by **March 1, 2009**. Allow a month to get the required information and references.

SELECTION — In general, preference will be given to students planning to attend colleges in New York State. Initial screening will be done by area selection committees. Scholarships will be offered only to students entering an accredited major program in a four year institution. Final selection will be made by the State Selection Committee.

Applications should be obtained either from your Area Scholarship Chairperson listed below or from the NYSASHP:RD website www.nysahp.org. Counties with each area are listed on the back page of this brochure. Applications should be returned to your Area Chairperson.

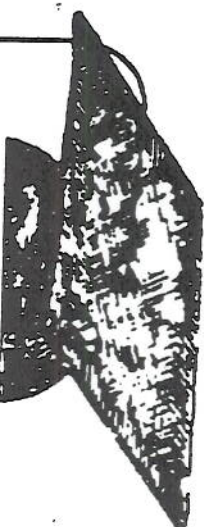
