- Application is to be completed by Applicant. **Applicant is required to provide 2 essays as noted below, summary of school and community activities, grade transcript, and 2 letters of reference.**
- Application deadline is January 15th.
- Initial receipt of \$500 per academic years, for up to 4 consecutive years of undergraduate studies, will be upon proof of active, full-time enrollment in an agricultural-related major at the designated college.
- Subsequent funding will be dependent upon continued full-time enrollment in an agricultural-related major and a 2.7 out of 4.0 academic average. Transcript to be provided by student at the end of each year.
- Current employee and director family members are exempt from receiving scholarship.
