Dear Parents,

According to our records, your child is eligible to attend kindergarten at Mohansic Elementary School for the 2008/09 school year. On behalf of the Yorktown Central School District, I welcome you!

The registration process for 2008/09 kindergarten students is threefold:

1. Completing and returning the enclosed registration forms.
2. Pre-Kindergarten Screening (DIAL-3); Vision/Hearing/BMI Screenings
3. Kindergarten Orientation/Student Bus Ride

**Registration:** Please complete the following forms and mail them to Mohansic School in the enclosed, self-addressed, envelope by Wednesday, March 12, 2008.

1. Emergency Health Information card
  2. The Yorktown Central School District Registration Form
  3. Release of Records form - if your child has attended a preschool, this form should be completed by you and returned to us with your completed registration papers.
  4. Home Language Questionnaire (HLQ)
  5. Parent Questionnaire For Kindergarten In-take
  6. Application for transportation to/from day care location (if applicable). Must be submitted no later than April 1.
  7. A copy of your child's birth certificate to be kept on file at the school. An original birth certificate (with official seal) must be presented for review at the time of your screening appointment.
  8. Health Office Packet
  9. ~~District Connect-ED Form/Emergency Contact Form~~
- Information about our Enrichment Center program is included

The immunization record must be received before a child can be admitted into kindergarten in September. All kindergarten entrants are required to show documentation of having received the following immunizations: Dtap-3 doses, Polio - 3 doses, Measles - 2 doses, Mumps - 1 dose, Rubella - 1 dose, Hepatitis B - 3 doses, Varicella (Chickenpox) - 1 dose. NYS Education Law requires a physical exam for all pupils entering school for the first time. Have your private physician complete the form, or the exam may be done by the school doctor, Dr. Deanna Sandor, in the fall.

You must call Mohansic to schedule your child's DIAL-3 Screening and Kindergarten Orientation/Bus Ride appointments.

Students with Last Names beginning with the letters A through M please call ONLY ON MARCH 10, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9:00 A.M. AND 2:30 P.M., AT 243-7235.

Students with Last Names beginning with the letters N through Z please call ONLY ON MARCH 11, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9:00 A.M. AND 2:30 P.M., AT 243-7235.

**DIAL-3 Screening:** Your child will be screened for kindergarten readiness, by appointment only, on the following dates: **Mon., May 5, Tu., May 6, Wed., May 7 (PM only), Thurs. May 8, Fri. May 9, Mon., May 12 and Tu. May 13** (if numbers make this date necessary.) Your appointment will last approximately 1½ hours; with your child having his/her vision, hearing and BMI (body mass index) screened immediately following the DIAL-3 Screening. Your child will be screened by Mohansic staff in the areas of language, concepts and motor skills. Arlene Klausner, our psychologist, will coordinate the screening, and share the results with you immediately after the session. Juice and cookies will be offered to the students, so please notify us if there are any dietary restrictions or allergies.

**Orientation/Bus Ride:** Kindergarten orientation will be held on **Wednesday, May 28, 2008** by appointment. We will have a morning and afternoon session. Children will visit a kindergarten classroom and take a short bus ride, while parents meet with me to discuss the kindergarten program. Thank you for your time and attention.
