

AP 11 2010-2011 Independent Reading Project

Over the course of 2010-2011 school year, you will select six books to read independently. Once you have completed reading each of these book, you will need to present the book to the class.

Attached you will find an article from July 30th's edition of *Newsweek*. This article is divided into eight topics. The eight topics represent the gist of what *Newsweek* calls "the most important stories of the moment." Your job is to select one title from six of these eight topics and read it. In other words, look at the topic "Rebel With a Cause." These books deal with politics. If you are interested in politics, you would select one of the books from this category and read it. If politics are not that interesting to you right now, you could skip this category all together. You can only skip two categories, however.
