

AP 11 2009-2010 Independent Reading Project

Over the course of 2009-2010 school year, you will select six books to read independently. Once you have completed reading each of these book, you will need to either present the book to the class or turn in a writing assignment over the book. Attached you will find a list of 50 titles. You need to choose all six books from this list. Also, of the six books you choose, at least three of them need to be non-fiction.

Due dates:

Book 1:	Due 9/28	Presentation
Book 2:	Due 11/9	Presentation
Book 3:	Due 3/1	Written Report
Book 4:	Due 3/26	Written Report
Book 5:	Due 5/3	Written Report
Book 6:	Due 5/28	Presentation

Here are a few modifications:

If you chooses a book that is over 700 pages, it will count as two and be due on the second date.

If you choose #5 *The Bear* by William Faulkner, you need to read the entire story collection in which *The Bear* appears. The collection is called Go Down Moses.

If you choose #16, you need to meet with me and discuss which sections you will be reading.

If you choose #21, you may read either Life on the Mississippi or Pudd'nhead Wilson.

If you choose #42, you need to read all three books as one longer novel (about 550 pages total).
