

## VOTRE CLASSEUR FRANÇAIS

To help you keep yourself organized, you will be required to keep a binder for French 2. The binder will be collected and checked when we have a unit test. The completeness/organization of your binder counts for 10 points on the unit test (unit tests are normally 100 points total).

You will need:

- a) a binder with 2 side pockets and 3 rings in the center
- b) 7 dividers

The following information goes on the front cover:

- a) Your name
- b) Français 2

Leave the pockets empty for now...

The binder needs to be divided as follows:

- 1) in the front of everything: your kwik wipe sheet (these will be distributed by the teacher).
- 2) Behind the 1<sup>st</sup> divider: syllabus, participation/preparation rubric, writing correction codes.
- 3) Behind the 2<sup>nd</sup> divider: maps of France and Europe
- 3) Behind 3<sup>rd</sup> divider: your list of *verbes par Coeur*
- 4) Behind 4<sup>th</sup> divider: vocabulary lists for FR 2 (in order from newest to oldest)
- 5) Behind 5<sup>th</sup> divider: grammar notes for FR 2 (in order from newest to oldest)

- 6) Behind 6<sup>th</sup> divider: VOCAB LISTS FROM FR 1 (in order from unit 1 to unit 6). [Mr. Hedge told you to keep these, remember?]
- 7) Behind 7<sup>th</sup> divider: GUIDED GRAMMAR NOTES FROM FR 1 (in order from unit 1 to unit 6). [you were supposed to have kept these, too].

*IF YOU DID NOT KEEP THE VOCAB/GRAMMAR NOTES FROM FR 1 YOU ARE IN LUCK, THEY ARE ALL ON MR. HEDGE'S WEB SITE, YOU'LL NEED TO PRINT THEM OUT AND COMPLETE THEM AT HOME, HOWEVER.*
