

# Luke's Passion/Resurrection

1. The Conspiracy Against Jesus 22: 1-6
  - Passover Time
  - Chief Priests and Scribes = seeking death but afraid of people
  - Satan entered Judas
  
2. Preparations for Passover.22:7-13
  - Jesus give instructions to Peter and John
  - Find man with jar of water, he has an upper room
  - They did exactly as Jesus told them
  -
  
3. The Last Supper 22: 14-20
  - Apostles and Jesus
  - Took ,bless, broke, gave
  - Cup = new covenant
  -
  
4. The Betrayal Foretold 22: 21-23
  - Jesus says someone will betray him
  - Apostles debate among selves who it is.
  -
  
5. Role of the Disciples 22: 24-30
  - Argument of who should be the greatest among the disciples
  - Jesus says the one who serves shall be greater
  -
  
6. Peter's Denial Foretold 22:31-34
  - Jesus tells Peter he must be strong, but that he will deny Jesus 3x
  -
  
7. Instructions for the Time of Crisis 22:35-38
  - Jesus speaks about having enough, the disciples think he is speaking of swords
  -
  
8. Agony of the Garden 22:39-46
  - Take this cup from me
  - Sweat = drops of blood
  - Disciples sleeping from grief
  -

9. Betrayal and Arrest of Jesus 22: 47-53

- Judas kisses Jesus to hand him over
- Disciple cuts off ear of chief priest's servant
- Jesus heals the ear.
- The hour of darkness has come
- 

10. Peter's Denial of Jesus 22: 54-65

- Jesus is taken to High Priest. Peter stays at a distance
- Maid asks Peter if he knows Jesus / Peter says No
- Another asking / Peter says no
- Someone else asked/ Peter says NO
- Cock crow / Peter remembers, weeps bitterly
- Jesus is blindfolded and beaten
- 

11. Jesus is Brought Before the Sanhedrin 22: 66-71

- Council of elders of the people, both chief priests and scribes
- Jesus is accused of saying he is the Son of God.
- 

12. Jesus Before Pilate 23: 1-5

- Pilate asks "Are you the king of the Jews?"
- Jesus does not answer
- Pilate says Jesus is innocent
- 

13. Jesus Before Herod 23:6-16

- Pilate sends Jesus to Herod
- Herod questions Jesus at length
- Chief priests and scribes kept accusing him harshly
- Jesus is mocked by Herod's men and sent back to Pilate
- Pilate finds Jesus to be innocent and has him flogged to please the chief priests and scribes

14. The Sentence of Death 23:18-25

- Crowd shouted they wanted Barabbas
- Pilate says a third time that Jesus is innocent
- Pilate granted their request for crucifixion and released Barabbas

#### 15. The Way of the Cross 23:26-32

- Simon is made to carry Jesus' cross
- A large crowd followed including woman
  - Jesus comforts them
  - Two other criminals were led away to be crucified with him
  -

#### 16. The Crucifixion 23: 33-43

- Place of the Skull
- Jesus in middle of two criminals
- "Father forgive for they do not know what they do." Lk 23:34
- Jesus is mocked by the crowd./ Soldiers jeered
- Save yourself!
- Conversation between criminal....."you will be with me in paradise"
- (43)
- 

#### 17. Death of Jesus 23: 44-49

- Noon til 3: darkness covered the entire earth/ because of eclips of sun
- Veil of Temple torn down the middle
- Jesus cries out "Father into your hands I commend my Spirit." 23:46
- Centurion says that Jesus was an innocent man
- Friends were at a distance
- 

#### 18. The Burial of Jesus 23:50-56

- Joseph: virtuous and righteous, member of the council
  - Asks Pilate for Jesus' body
  - Wrapped him in a linen cloth and laid him in a rock-hewn tomb
- Women from Galilee followed behind , then went to go get spices / they rested on the Sabbath
- 

#### 19. The Resurrection of Jesus. 24:1-12

- Women with spices went to tomb on the first day of the week
- Found stone rolled away / did not find the body / they were puzzled
- 2 men in dazzling garments appeared to them.

- women were terrified and bowed to the ground
- Men ask: why seek the living among the dead? Jesus has been raised
- Women return to the 11 to tell them what happened
- Mary Magdalene, Joanna, and Mary the mother of James
- No one believed them
- Peter went to the tomb, saw empty tomb and was amazed.

#### 20. Appearance on the Road to Emmaus 24:13-35

- Two men encounter the risen Jesus /They don't recognize him until they break bread with him
- Men tell others of the news
- 

#### 21. Appearance to the Disciples in Jerusalem 24: 36-49

- Jesus appears to Disciples: they were startled and amazed, they thought they were seeing a ghost
- Jesus showed them his wounds, they were amazed and joyful
- Jesus asks for something to eat
- Jesus quotes Scripture to them and tells them to stay in the city until they are "clothed with power from on high." Lk 24:49
- 

#### 22. The Ascension 24: 50-53

- Jesus took them to Bethany/ blessed them/ and was taken up into heaven
- Disciples paid him homage / returned to Jerusalem joyfully
- Went to the Temple to praise God.
