10	The number of categories in the Dewey Decimal System.
999.999	The Dewey Decimal System begins with the number 000 and ends with the number _____.
Abbreviations	Shortened forms of words that are usually followed by periods.
Almanac	A book published once a year that has facts, charts, graphs, and statistics.
Alphabetical Order	Words are arranged in this order in dictionaries and encyclopedias.
Appendix	The section of a book that contains additional facts and information.
Atlas	A book of maps.
Author, Title, Subject, Key Word	Four different ways you can search for a book.
Call Number	How you locate a book on a nonfiction shelf.
Cover	The outside of the book.
Dedication Page	The page in a book that contains a short note from the author in which a special person or persons are remembered or thanked.
Definition	The meaning of a word.
Dictionary	A book used to find the meaning, spelling, and pronunciation of a word.
Due Date	The day when you need to bring an item back to the library.
Encyclopedias	Reference books with information about people, places, and events that are organized into volumes from A to Z.
FIG	The call letters that represent fiction books.
Glossary	A list in the back that defines the words found in that book.
Guide Words	The two words at the top of each dictionary page.
Index	A list in the back of the book that lists main points, as well as the page number where you would find the information.
Key Word	If you don't remember the title or author of a book you could search for it using this method.
Library Media Center	A place where you gather information from books, computers, CDs, and maps. You can also check the items out.
Media Specialist or Librarian	A person who can help you find the information in the Media Center or library.
Melvil Dewey	The person who created the library call number system.
Newbery Award	The annual award given to the best American books for children.
Nonfiction	The type of books that are shelved numerically in the Dewey Decimal System.
Numerical Order	The order that nonfiction books are arranged in.
REF	The call letters that represent reference books.
Spine	Where the call numbers on a book are located.
Table of Contents	A list that tells what is included in a book and what page numbers chapters start on.
Thesaurus	A book of synonyms and antonyms.
Title Page	The page in a book where you can find the title, author, and illustrator.
Verso	A left-hand page.
Volume	What each separate book in a set is called.
