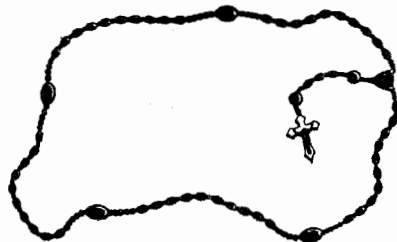
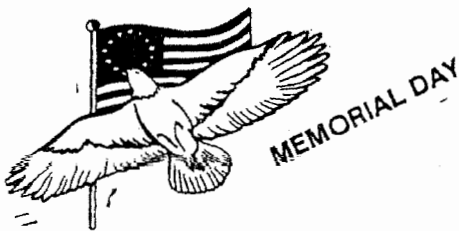

National Teacher's Appreciation Day is May 5, 2009. What a great time to say thank you to all of our teachers for their hard work and the time that they spend with our children.

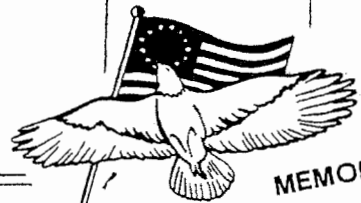
The school trip is June 5, 2009 to Dorney Park & Wildwater Kingdom. All payments are due by Monday, May 11, 2009.
