Our school year is off to a wonderful and exciting start. We have several new students and their families that we welcome to St. Cyprian Catholic School. There will be a New Parents Meeting on October 14, 2009 from 6:30 PM until 7:30 PM. The meeting will be a great opportunity to meet other parents, ask questions, and share any concerns that you may have. All parents and guardians of new students are encouraged to attend!

Cyprian Capers: The collaboration between St. Cyprian Catholic School and the Academy of Notre Dame de Namur will continue this school year. The science and social studies enrichment program will have grades 3 and 4 travel to the Academy of Notre Dame to participate in academic enrichment programs. This exchange program is scheduled to begin October 1, 2009.

Fall Fundraiser: The fall fundraiser begins on October 5 and runs until October 19, 2009. Please make every effort to support our school through participation in our fundraisers. The dollars that are raised go directly to support your child's education. Remember that there is a \$250.00 fundraiser requirement per family that must be settled before the end of the school year. The fall fundraiser is the first of three that we will have throughout the year to help families meet this obligation.

Teachers In-Service: There will be a teacher in-service on October 12, 2009 for all Catholic Elementary Schools in District Two. Therefore, School will be closed for the children on that day.

School Mass: Mass will be held on Tuesday, October 20 at 9 AM. All are Welcome to attend!

Safe Environment Classes: From October 26 until October 30, our students will receive classes on how to be aware of their surroundings, what constitutes a safe environment, and the procedures to follow if they feel that their safety is in danger.

Progress Reports: Your child will receive a progress report on Wednesday, October 28, 2009. Look for this in Wednesday's communication folder of that week. If you do not receive a progress report, or you have questions about the report that you did receive, please contact your child's teacher.

Mock Elections: The children will participate in mock elections to experience the voting process and develop a deeper understanding of our democratic system.
