A practical approach is taken to involve parents at Roosevelt Elementary. Parents are actively sought out to provide them with the opportunity to become involved in their child's educational experience. Throughout the year, several opportunities are provided for parents to become involved. The following is a brief overview of those opportunities:

- ⇒ Goals Days are held at the end of the first nine weeks of the school year and provide parents with an opportunity to meet with teachers concerning their child's progress. Progress reports are given to parents during this conference.
- ⇒ For those parents seeking to improve their parenting skills, workshops and information are offered to all parents of students at Roosevelt Elementary. Workshops and information are provided through Lubbock agencies and the elementary campus.
- ⇒ Parenting tips are offered during monthly parent meetings.
- ⇒ Parent orientation for students is held prior to the beginning of the school year.
- ⇒ Literature and other information is provided to parents to ensure they are aware of and exposed to current and positive parenting strategies and techniques.
- ⇒ Phone numbers of agencies from which parents may seek assistance are available in the elementary counselor's office.
