Prompt:

- ◆ Copy the above quote and its author exactly as it appears. Then, analyze it by answering the questions below.
- ◆ For each question, your reply should be a minimum of three sentences long.
- ◆ When you finish writing, your analysis should be anywhere from half (½) a page to one (1) full page in length.

Questions:

1. What does the above the quotation mean *to you*?
2. How does the meaning of this quotation connect to *Ender's Game*?
3. How does the meaning of this quotation connect to your own life?
4. How does the meaning of this quotation connect to the world in general.
HINT: Think of a current event that exemplifies the meaning of this quote—something you've heard about in the news, read about in a magazine, discussed in another class, read about online, etc.
