**Prompt:**

- ❖ Analyze the above quotation using the following format.
  - ❖ Each section **MUST** be a minimum of three (3) sentences.
  - ❖ When you finish writing, your analysis should be anywhere from half (½) a page to one (1) full page in length.

- Begin by copying the quote and its author exactly as it appears.
  
  - **Section #1:** Explain what the quotation means *to you*. In your explanation, define the underlined vocabulary (if applicable). ***\*If you don’t know what the vocabulary means, then look it up in a dictionary and/or thesaurus. Be sure that the definition you give explains what the vocabulary means in the context of this quotation!\****
  
  - **Section #2:** Connect this quotation to a piece of “literature.” ***\*You may use anything that you’ve read inside or outside of this class such as a novel, a play, a poem, a short story; a movie that you’ve seen; a television program that you’ve watched; a play that you’ve been to; a song that you’ve heard; a piece of artwork that you’ve seen; etc. \****
  
  - **Section #3:** Connect this quotation to your own life.
  
  - **Section #4:** Connect this quotation to the world in general.
