

# REWARDS

Helping students to develop intrinsic rewards for a job well done will be a focus of the year, however, there will be a few small ways in which I recognize those students who exhibit responsibility and good behavior. They include the following:

- \* Verbal and written recognition
- \* Positive notes and phone calls home
- \* Occasional movie/pizza parties
- \* Hall of Fame

Hall of Fame occurs every Friday in class. Student who meet the following criteria for the week are recognized at this time:

1. No late assignments for the week.
2. No missing assignments.
3. Passing grades or demonstration of understanding of concept on all assignments.  
(Students not receiving passing grades or not showing an understanding of the concept will have the opportunity to redo the assignment in order to meet the expected standard.)
4. No more than one strike in a week (green or yellow showing on the Strike Chart).
5. No blue slips from recess.

Students who qualify for the Hall of Fame will have their pictures hung on the Hall of Fame Wall and will receive a large sticker for their Hall of Fame cards. Students are also able to earn large stickers for a variety of other activities. For every ten stickers earned, students will receive a "special treat. " After twenty stickers are earned, students are invited to a special lunch in the classroom with ice cream provided by me!

# CONSEQUENCES

For those students who choose not to follow the standards established at the beginning of the year, discipline will be firm, fair, and consistent. The following system of consequences will be present in Room 20 on a weekly basis:

- 1st strike - Warning
- 2nd strike - Missed recess
- 3rd strike - Note to parent
- 4th strike - Conference with parent, teacher, and student

Parents will be notified immediately if their child engages in any severe behavior (e.g., fighting, defiance of a teacher or adult, destructive behavior).
