Dear Spartans Parents and Friends,

The instrumental music students are currently involved in a fund raiser, for which we would like your support. Students and/or their parents may check out up to 3 coupon cards at a time to sell to friends, family, neighbors, and acquaintances. Businesses represented on the cards include Kentucky Fried Chicken, Cold Stone Ice-cream, Sonic, Del Taco, Subway, IHop, Wing Stop, Papa Murphy's, Best Buy, Paradise Cleaners, Midas, Ace Hardware, Brunswick, and FastTrack Airport Parking, Elitch Gardens., and The Mammoth. The cards sell for \$10. Our program will make \$4.50 on the sale of each card. This fund raiser ends September 17th.

Because we pay for any cards not returned to the company at the end of our sale, we need everyone participating to understand that any cards they check out, which are not sold, need to be returned to Mrs. Johnson. Any cards not returned to the teacher must be paid for. Once the cards have been sold the money needs to be turned into Mrs. Johnson. There's no limit to the number of cards a family may sell, simply ask for more cards once you've turned in money for the first set of cards.

If a customer wants to write a check, please have them make it payable to: **TJ Partners**, and write "instrumental music" on the memo line.

Money earned from this fundraiser will be used to repair equipment and purchase music. Our immediate needs include new heads for the marching percussion equipment; strings for the school violins, violas, and cello (especially the cello); and we need bows for our three bass players (they're using viola and violin bows). We also are in need of music that is appropriate for our instrumentation.
