<i>Ethics</i>	Score of 20 or more on Teacher Recommendation Worksheet.	Consistent behavior as entrance. One referral (or more) will result in probation.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unprepared often • Incomplete binder • 2 referrals in a school year
