Reminder: VIRTUS

Volunteers who assist with school activities on a regular basis must attend *VIRTUS: Protecting God's Children Workshop (Safe Environment Program)* and successfully complete a background clearance prior to engaging in volunteer services. You do not have to take the workshop at St. Francis. Several locations are available throughout the diocese. Please log onto www.diogh.org to register online. Click on link Safe Environment; then click on VIRTUS training.

Grandparents Day- Volunteers help with set-up and food preparation the day before, and serving and clean-up that day.

New Family Ambassador- Volunteer will be assigned a new family to the school. They will help answer general questions about the school or events, and get together during the summer. This position is for both parent and child.

Teacher Appreciation- Volunteers will provide treats to faculty and staff during the first week of May (Teacher Appreciation Week)

PTO social committee- plans social events for our parents and families (non fundraising)

PTO Bingo Night- volunteers needed to walk around and sell bingo cards (must be an adult)

Yearbook- assists Yearbook coordinator in taking pictures at different events for the school

Grade Coordinator- works with teachers and parents to coordinate events for their grade level, including the Christmas party, end of the year party, teacher appreciation lunch, and carline

PTO Nominations Committee- these volunteers will meet beginning in January to recommend volunteers for PTO's board and standing committees coordinators, and grade coordinators for the following school year. Also responsible for contacting these people to see if those recommended would like to be on the PTO ballot or would like to fulfill the position.

Clinic Helper- assists the nurse by organizing kids for various screenings- eyes, ears, etc.

45th Anniversary Committee- will assist advancement office coordinate various events

Hospitality- helps committee coordinator with refreshments needed at PTO events/Open Houses

School Supply Sale- helps during the school supply sale- cashiers, runners, and general volunteers

Walk-A-Thon- volunteers help coordinators both prior and day of this big fundraising event for PTO

Playground- responsible for checking playground and coordinating any needed maintenance or upkeep

Landscaping- coordinate any further landscape needs for the school.

Picture Day Helper- helps organize the kids having school pictures taken

Weekly Christmas Shop and Donate A Book Fair- volunteers will work shifts to help with the two Fundraisers for the school library.

Library Christmas Shop/Book Fair- assists librarian with setting up, sales, and checkout for these Fundraisers for the school Library. Christmas Shop is early December, and Donate a Book Fair is during Catholic Schools Week.

Cheerleading- assists Cheerleader coordinator with parent communication and assists as school liaison

Boys/Girls Athletic Liaison- acts as the communication line between the coaches and parents regarding information about game schedules, schedule changes, and other important news

Athletics Schedule Coordinator- responsible for maintaining the schedule of parent volunteers for bus rides and snack duty for away games and concessions during home games.

Blue & Gold Awards- assists in the planning of the yearly sports award banquet
